The Nexus Place Project involved the stripping of the building back to the original concrete structure , and addition of four floors. The facade treatment involves two unitized facade systems, one of which is traditional , with the other being developed from bespoke extrusions to achieve the variety of angles on the upper floors. The complex corners incorporate a hybrid unitized system whereby spandrel panels are fixed to the slab edge and the vertical glazed panels stack on top of them.
