Grand Canal Square is a speculative office development in Dublin . Its facade comprises of a factory fabricated, unitised form of cladding construction. The cladding panels are a narrow form of twin skin construction with outward opening glass door vents, integrated motorised venetian blinds to aid with the overall solar control performance. This BREEAM Excellent standard office building outer is glass is typically treated with a bespoke baked on ceramic frit pattern.
